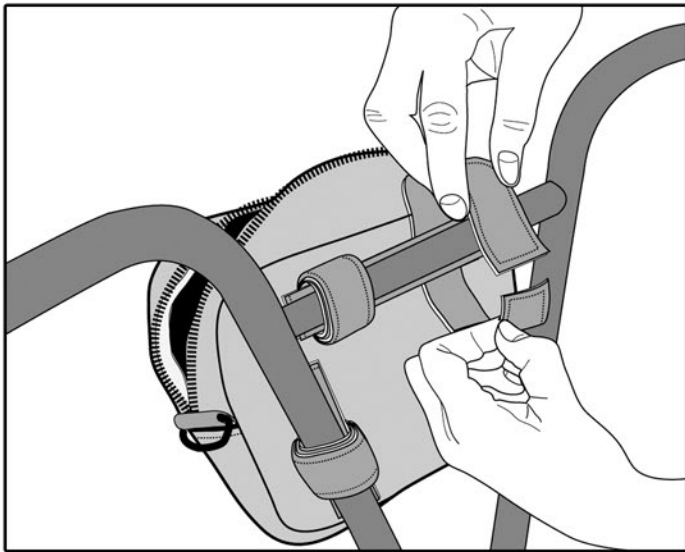
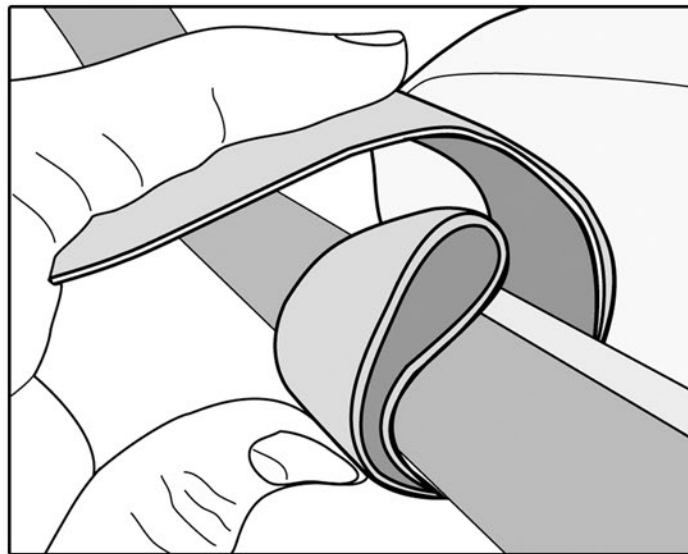


Instructions NR-100 Highway Handlebar Bag

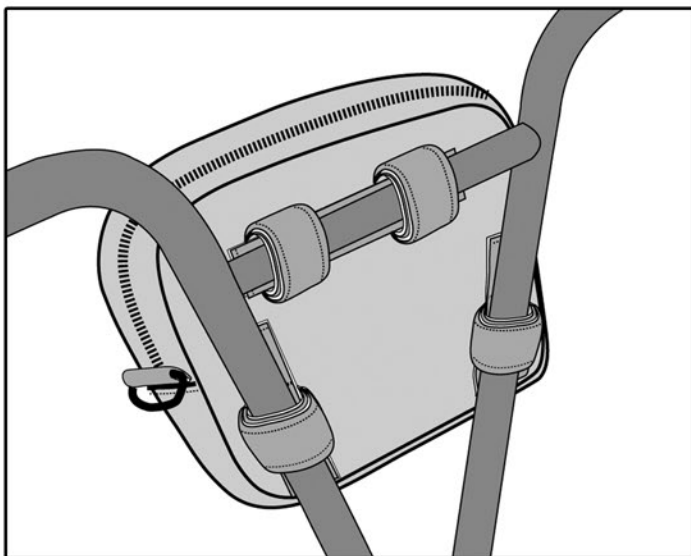
Please read instructions carefully before installation. We recommend this product be installed by a qualified and experienced motorcycle technician. If you are unsure of any of the below directions and/or your ability to correctly and securely install this product, please contact us or your local dealer for help. Below diagrams show typical installation, your motorcycle may be different so please use diagrams as a guide. Make sure your motorcycle is clean and free from dirt, road grime, etc. where the Nelson-Rigg luggage mounts.



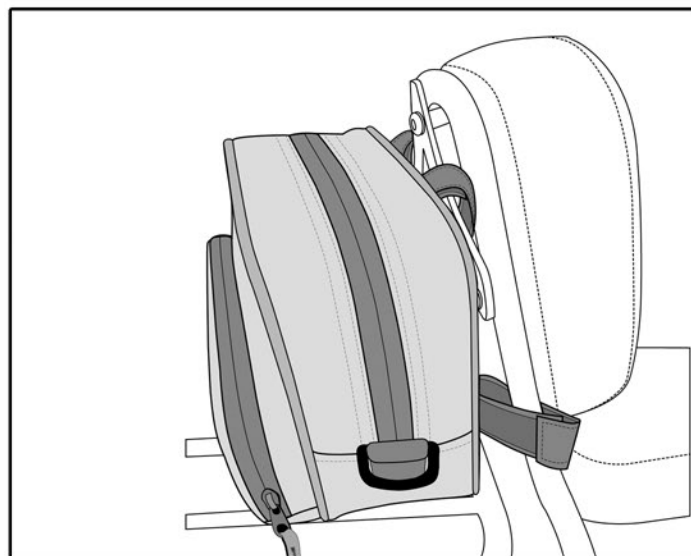
Line up the bag to handlebars,
Pick points to attach using a minimum of 4 of the 6 hook and loop straps included. Feed straps through MOLLE web loops on back of the bag and wrap tightly around the bars.



Strap may be folded inward if too long or rider may choose to trim length (if strap is cut, use lighter to lightly melt the end so material won't fray).



Bag is attached when both vertical and horizontal straps are in place.



Place bag on a luggage rack or passenger seat. Using the supplied hook and loop straps, pass them around the frame of your backrest and wrap tightly around the bars.

Warning:

Read the installation instructions and make yourself familiar with the process of installing the Nelson-Rigg® product(s) on your bike. It is your responsibility to mount the product correctly and securely as outlined in these instructions. Nelson-Rigg® products are intended for use at USA street legal speeds as posted by the individual States. Nelson-Rigg® luggage must not be overloaded. Max carrying capacity is 5lbs including the weight of the bag or the maximum load suggested by the manufacturer of the vehicle, whichever is less. Failure to adhere to these warnings may result in, but not be limited to: the luggage becoming detached, the product becoming tangled in moving parts of the vehicle, unstable vehicle dynamics, reduction in the ability to control the vehicle. The result(s) could lead to serious injury or death. Always ride safely, adhering to the local highway regulations. Always wear a helmet and protective apparel.
